1	An act to provide a "Sleeve" for every Kentucky classroom to prevent unlawful entry.

3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	
6	Section 1: Provide each classroom in Kentucky with a "Sleeve". The "Sleeve" is a new device to lock doors to
7	keep shooters out and protect students.
8	
9	Section 2: Every teacher will be required to go through training on how to use the "Sleeve" properly.
10	
11	Section 3: The state lottery will fund the initial cost for each school. After that, for any buildings added,
12	each school district will fund that cost. (\$65.00 per sleeve)
13	
14	Section 4: No penalties because all schools must comply for the protection of the students of Kentucky.
15	
16	Section 5: This bill will go into effect, Summer 2015, which will give all teachers time to be trained and allow
17	enough money to be generated from the lottery to buy the "Sleeves".
