



KENTUCKY YOUTH ASSEMBLY YOUTH GOVERNORS REPORT

Since 1946, the Kentucky YMCA has proudly sponsored the Kentucky Youth Assembly, or KYA – the nation's largest Youth and Government program for middle and high school students.

As KYA delegates, students can serve as Representatives and Senators, Justices and Attorneys, Cabinet Secretaries, Lobbyists, or members of our Media Corps. During the fall, delegates work with their school delegations to research and write legislation that they will sponsor at the Assembly.

The 2019 KYA session was our largest program yet, with hundreds of KY youth participating in debate for the first time. Over the course of 7 assemblies – 4 High School and 3 Middle School – the Y served more students, families, schools, and communities than ever before.



At each KYA conference, Governors meet with the sponsors of bills passed by the House and Senate, and consult with the Cabinet and Budget Committee before deciding to sign or veto each bill.
