1 An act to Receive Early Life Termination

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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

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5 Section 1: This act will require that the person will have an illness with no treatment, that will likely
6 result in death within six months

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8 Section 2: If the patient is clinically depressed or under the age of 18, this act does not apply to them.

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10 Section 3: The patient must make 2 oral requests (15 days apart) and a written request. The written
11 request must be witnessed by 2 people (not including the patient's physician), one of which must be
12 legally related to the patient. The patient must be physically and mentally capable of self-administering
13 the aid-in-dying dmg.

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15 Section 4: A physician is required to complete a full assessment of the patient's medical history and
16 current condition. If the physician believes the patient's request is impaired in any way due to
17 depression or mental illness, tests and evaluations are required for the patient to pass before the
18 physician can carry out the patient's wishes
