1 An act to increase the frequency of speed limit signs on roadways throughout the Commonwealth of
2 Kentucky.
3

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
5

6 Section 1: This bill will require all 120 counties in the state of Kentucky to put in place a higher
7 frequency of speed limit signs.
8

9 Section 2: Currently, throughout the Commonwealth there are few regulations regarding the placement
10 of speed limit signs, with some occurrences having signs at a respectful distance, where others are
11 simply too far away.
12

13 Section 3: This bill would mandate the provision of additional, state-funded, 15 signs per 100 square
14 miles. This bill would also put in a maximum distance between signs of 5 miles of highways and 1 mile
15 on any other road.
16

17 Section 4: This bill would be enacted once signed into law, and all signs must be put in place one year
18 after signing, November 2017.

20 Section 5: This bill would cost approximately \$181,840.50. All of this can be funded from the
21 \$700,000,079 budget for Highway Management according to The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet
22 from 2015-2016.
