1 2	An act to allow 15 year old youths in Kentucky to get Learner's Permits.
2 3 4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
5 6 7	Section 1: This bill allows 15 year old youths to take the written test on road safety and laws to get their permit.
8 9 10	Section 2: The teen will have to hold their permit for 365 day, complete 70 hours of practice driving with at least 20 hours at night, and complete a Driver's Education Course before getting their Intermediate License.
11 12 13	Section 3: This bill helps the teen by allowing him/her to drive through all four seasons with an adult.
14 15 16	Section 4: When a teen turns 16 and 6 months or held their Intermediate License for 180 days, then they may apply for a full unrestricted license.
17 18	Section 5: Any cost will be founded by the Department of Motor Vehicles.
19 20	Section 6: This bill will go into effect 6 months upon passage.
21 22	Section 7: When this bill goes into effect, any teen between 15 and 16 can choose to get their permit or wait until they turn 16, but will have to hold the permit for 365 days.
