

1	An act to reduce the total cost of the Epipen for those without insurance.
2 3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4 5 6 7	Section 1: Epipen prices have increased 500% over recent years. This bill will mandate that Epipens never rise about \$120.
8 9	Section 2: These auto injectors have become mandatory in all Kentucky schools, police departments, fire departments, EMS vehicles, and doctor offices.
10 11 12 13	Section 3: Mylan Company has become a monopoly due to them being the only wide spread producers of the Epipen. Being that it is illegal to run a monopoly, we should address the issue of price inflation.
14 15 16	Section 4: If the company raises the rates of Epipen that company would pay fines. First offense-A fine of \$25,000 Second offense- A fine of \$100,000
17 18	Third offense- This will result in a lawsuit from the Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services.

19 Section 5: This bill will go into effect one month after it is passed.
