1 An act to reduce the total cost of the Epipen for those without insurance.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: Epipen prices have increased 500% over recent years. This bill will mandate that Epipens
6 never rise about \$120.

7

8 Section 2: These auto injectors have become mandatory in all Kentucky schools, police departments,
9 fire departments, EMS vehicles, and doctor offices.

11 Section 3: Mylan Company has become a monopoly due to them being the only wide spread producers
12 of the Epipen. Being that it is illegal to run a monopoly, we should address the issue of price inflation.

14 Section 4: If the company raises the rates of Epipen that company would pay fines.

15 First offense-A fine of \$25,000

16 Second offense- A fine of \$100,000

17 Third offense- This will result in a lawsuit from the Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services.

19 Section 5: This bill will go into effect one month after it is passed.
