1 An act to reduce sentencing for non-violent, non-sexual crimes
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: Non-violent and non-sexual crimes are defined as property, drug, and public order
6 offenses that do not include harmful or sexual threats or attacks upon a victim.
7
8 Section 2: In Kentucky the prison population is 21,657. however the crime in Kentucky is about
9 15% lower than the national average. 91% of Kentucky's crimes are property crimes, and the
10 other 9% are violent crimes.
11
12 Section 3: This bill aims to lessen the sentences of non-violent, non-sexual offenders and to
13 increase the maximum time off allowed for good behavior from 60 days per year to 90 days per
14 year for non-violent, non-sexual offenders.
15
16 Section 4: This bill will go into effect January 1, 2017.
