An act to End Religious Discrimination in Private Schools

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Private Schools shall not be permitted to alter tuition fees based on a student’s religious beliefs.

Section 2: Any private school that does not comply with section 1 will be fined the amount of money equal to the tuition of the student that the case pertains too, and any other fees involving the case.

Section 3: If a private school is reported of charging a student more money on the basis of religious beliefs they will be subjected to an audit.

Section 4: If a report is filed against a private school for charging a student more money on the foundation of religious beliefs and the school refutes the accusations, proof of why the student is being charged more will have to be shown.

Section 5: This legislation only applies to schools who admit students who have different religious beliefs.

Section 6: Private schools still reserve the right to deny admittance regardless of religious beliefs.

Section 7: This bill will go into effect in the 2017-2018 school year.
