An act to amend state child labor laws to to include those over 18 still in high school

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: This bill will amend state child labor laws to include those over 18 still enrolled in high school until completion of their high school education.

Section 2: Whereas current state labor laws state that once someone turns 18, they are considered an adult in the work force. Therefore, they are considered able to work "adult hours" and no longer protected by the child labor laws. For children under the age of 18, labor laws state that they may not work after 10:30 pm preceding a school day and until 1:00 am on non-school days. Currently those turning 18 while still in school are no longer protected by these laws.

Section 3: Therefore, any violations of this law will result in the penalties imposed by the Labor Department for violations of child labor laws.

Section 4: This bill will require no addition funding and will become effective August 1, 2017.
