- 1 An act to Prohibit the Distribution and Use of Disposable Cups Over 24 Ounces in Restaurants in the
2 State of Kentucky
3
- 4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
5
- 6 Section 1: The act, when implemented, would prohibit the distribution of disposable cups over the size
7 of twenty-four (24) ounces by any business or enterprise within the Commonwealth.
8
- 9 Section 2: This act, when implemented, would not require any funding from the state.
10
- 11 Section 3: The penalties for violating this law would be as follows: Upon the first offense, the business
12 would receive a warning from the Kentucky Health Department in addition to a \$1000 fine. On the
13 second offense, the establishment would receive a 3-4 business week probation period in which they
14 will not be permitted to sell their products. Upon a third offense, complete shutdown of the
15 establishment, enforced by Kentucky Health Department.

- 17 Section 4: The bill will be enacted on February 1st, 2017.
