1 An act to require all epinephrine auto-injector device distributors to abide by a price ceiling of \$350.

2

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4

5 Section 1: This bill requires that all companies, distributors, and manufacturers of epinephrine auto-
6 injector devices abide by a price ceiling of \$350.

8 Section 2: Epinephrine is a drug that is used to treat anaphylaxis, a potentially deadly allergic reaction

9

10 Section 3: The Kentucky Department of Health, along with the Kentucky Department of the Treasury,
11 will enforce this bill.

13 Section 4: Failure to comply with these new regulations will result in penalties depending on the extent
14 of disobedience:

15 The company first receives a warning.

16 All companies that do not abide by the price ceiling will be reprimanded and be fined \$100 per auto-
17 injector sold as a final offense.

18 The \$100 fine will be applied to all further and reoccurring offenses.

20 Section 5: This bill poses no cost to the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

22 Section 6: All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.

24 Section 7: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2017 with the signature of the governor.
