1 An act to require patients receiving mammograms to be informed if they have dense breast tissue.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: This proposal will require medical professionals to inform patients who received a
6 mammogram if their breasts contain dense tissue.
7
8 Section 2: This proposal will require medical professionals to give patients this information at the same
9 time they deliver the results of the mammogram, either in person or over the phone.
10
11 Section 3: The head of the department in which the mammogram is administered will enforce this
12 proposal.
13
14 Section 4: Failure to abide by this proposal, if enacted, will result in the following penalties:
15 First offense: The physician who ordered the mammogram will be issued a warning.
16 Second offense: The physician who ordered the mammogram will receive a one-week suspension.
17 Third offense: The physician who ordered the mammogram will receive a one-month suspension. With
18 each additional offense, the physician will receive a one-month suspension as well as a \$500 fine.

20 Section 5: There is no additional cost for this proposal.
21
22 Section 6: All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this proposal are hereby repealed.
23
24 Section 7: This proposal will go into effect on January first (1st), 2017 with the signature of the
25 Governor.
