1 An act to mandate that all personal vehicles that receive 12 miles per gallon or less be banned from all
2 Kentucky roadways.
3

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

6 Section 1: As natural resources become increasingly exhausted, vehicles that receive 12 miles per
7 gallon (mpg) or less will be prohibited from using Kentucky highways and interstates in order to
8 provide conservation for natural resources that are essentially irreplaceable.

10 Section 2: Vehicles that do not comply with these regulations will be fined:

- 11 • 1st Offense: \$250 fine
- 12 • 2nd Offense: \$450 fine
- 13 • 3rd Offense: \$750 fine
- 14 • 4th Offense or any following offense will be punished with a \$1,500 fine.

16 Section 3: Dealerships offering vehicles that receive 12 mpg or less will be subject to a \$7,500 fee for
17 every vehicle the company licenses to sell in Kentucky.

19 Section 4: This bill will be enforced by the Kentucky Department of Motor Vehicles and will require that
20 all owners of a vehicle that receives 12 mpg or less be notified of the bill's enactment.

22 Section 5: Owners of vehicles that violate this policy will have the opportunity to sell their vehicles to
23 the state at 80% of the current MSRP value. This incentive will be funded by the Kentucky Department
24 of Transportation budget.

26 Section 6: This bill will go into effect six months after passage.
