1 An act to illegalize "double-dipping" (the act of simultaneously receiving a government pension while
2 holding a job.
3

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
5

6 Section 1: The Kentucky General Assembly will monitor the pensions and employment of Kentucky
7 citizens. Kentucky citizens will no longer be allowed to collect both a pension and an annual salary at
8 the same time. Those in violation of this will be fined an average of \$2,500 each time this occurs.

10 Section 2: Citizens currently receiving both a pension and an annual salary will follow the phase out
11 plan below:

- 12 • 1st year he/she will receive 85% of their pension
- 13 • 2nd year he/she will receive 65% of their pension
- 14 • 3rd year he/she will receive 45% of their pension
- 15 • 4th year he/she will receive 20% of their pension
- 16 • 5th year he/she will no longer receive a pension if still employed

18 Section 3: This plan will help get rid of "double dipping" without drastically affecting the annual income
19 of those citizens that currently receive a pension and an annual salary.

21 Section 4: This bill will take effect on January 1st, 2017.
