| 5 6 7 8 | Section 1: ILFN (Infrasound-low frequency noise) is noise less than 20 hertz, usually inaudible to humans. ILFN is perceptible to humans through the other senses besides hearing. Wind turbines create IFLN. |
| 9 10 11 12 | Section 2: The IFLN produced by wind turbines affects brain activity and can cause large amounts of stress on the body. Thus, the location of wind turbines must be at least 30 miles away from schools or areas with large populations. |
| 13 14 15 | Section 3: To eliminate as much of the frequency as possible, lattice absorbent walls will be placed around wind turbines. |
