1 An act to Change Columbus Day to Indigenous Peoples' Day

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: The second Monday in October will forevermore be renamed from Columbus Day to
6 Indigenous Peoples Day within the state of Kentucky.

7
8 Section 2: Any state-sanctioned teaching curriculum ordered originally on Columbus Day shall be
9 changed by the Kentucky Department of Education to educate about indigenous cultures.

11 Section 3: Schools and state agencies shall remain open on the second Monday of October.

13 Section 4: Any required renaming within state agencies to accommodate the change shall start on
14 January 1st, 2017 and be completed by October 9th, 2017.
