1 An act to create needle exchange programs across the state of Kentucky
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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
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5 Section 1: Aware that needle exchange programs are proven to help prevent HIV/AIDS, a free needle
6 service will be implemented in the state of Kentucky.
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8 Section 2: Health care facilities will be stocked with sanitary and sterilized syringes that will be given
9 out without questioning if a citizen requests.
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11 Section 3: There should be at least one NEP for every 5 counties.
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13 Section 4: Failure to implement a NEP in the area will result in a fine of \$5,000 and it will double for
14 each month not implemented.
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16 Section 5: Approximately \$160,000 will be allotted for each city that will have a free needle facility
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18 Section 6: This proposal will go into affect 90 days after passing.
