- 1 An act to make universal preschool available to all children of the age 3 to 5 regardless of circumstances.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: The current requirements for the ability to receive a preschool education is minimal to none in
- 6 the state of Kentucky. This bill will require the Kentucky Department of Education to make a preschool
- 7 education available to all children ages 3-5 regardless of extenuating circumstance(s).
- 8
- 9 Section 2: The universal preschool education will be offered in at least half of the public elementary
- 10 schools within a school district.
- 11
- 12 Section 3: Funding for universal preschool, in all Kentucky school districts, will come from lost SEEK
- 13 funding due to Senate Bill 24 and from Kentucky Lottery revenue.

- 15 Section 4: This bill will come into effect beginning with the 2017-2018 school year.
