An act to restrict all narcotic treatment program from being within 1,000 feet of schools, playgrounds, and other places where children gather

## Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Kentucky Administration Regulation 908 KAR 1:340 created in relation to KRS 218A.180 describes the rules and regulations of narcotic treatment programs. Under the current law, there are no restrictions on where these facilities must be located.

Section 2: A narcotic treatment program is defined as a substance abuse program using approved controlled substances and offering a range of treatment procedures and services for the rehabilitation of persons dependent on opium, morphine, heroin or any derivative or synthetic drug of that group.

Section 3: This bill will ensure that these narcotic treatment programs are no longer within a 1,000 feet radius of schools, playgrounds, and other places where children gather.

Section 4: This bill will go into effect January 1, 2017.
