1 An act to restrict all narcotic treatment program from being within 1,000 feet of schools, playgrounds,
2 and other places where children gather
3

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
5

6 Section 1: Kentucky Administration Regulation 908 KAR 1:340 created in relation to KRS 218A.180
7 describes the rules and regulations of narcotic treatment programs. Under the current law, there are
8 no restrictions on where these facilities must be located.
9

10 Section 2: A narcotic treatment program is defined as a substance abuse program using approved
11 controlled substances and offering a range of treatment procedures and services for the rehabilitation
12 of persons dependent on opium, morphine, heroin or any derivative or synthetic drug of that group.
13

14 Section 3: This bill will ensure that these narcotic treatment programs are no longer within a 1,000
15 feet radius of schools, playgrounds, and other places where children gather.

17 Section 4: This bill will go into effect January 1, 2017.
