- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

- 5 Section 1: This act withdraws Common Core standardized testing from public schools in Kentucky, and
- 6 proposes a new curriculum.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: Withdrawing Common Core will end the unpreparedness of students to take on real world
- 9 problems using what they have learned in the classroom. It will propose a new curriculum based on real
- 10 world issues in all subject areas.

- 12 Section 3: Teachers will not have to teach to the test, allowing for a well rounded education applicable
- 13 to real world problems.

- 15 Section 4: Withdrawing Common Core will not effect teacher salaries.

- 17 Section 5: This bill will go into effect when the 2018-2019 school year begins.
