1 An act to require driver’s education courses including how to respond to being pulled over.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: The purpose of this bill is to instruct drivers on how to react to being pulled over by a police
6 officer.
7
8 Section 2: This bill will teach drivers how to react when they are being pulled over by a police officer.
9 It will prevent the driver from doing anything that may seem like a red flag to the police officer. This
10 bill will be enforced by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet.

12 Section 3: After drivers receive their instruction permit, they must attend a drivers education course
13 before getting their full licenses. This bill will require the instructors to show them how to react
14 appropriately when getting pulled over.

16 Section 4: No funding is required for this bill because there is already a drivers education course. The
17 instructors will incorporate the additional training into their course.
18
19 Section 5: This bill will go into effect on January 1st, 2018.
