# 2016–2017 HIGH SCHOOL KYA & KUNA CHANGES

### **High School KYA & KUNA**

- **Chairs:** Delegations with over 50 students are eligible to have 2 delegates serve as Committee Chairs. Delegations with 50 students or less remain eligible to have 1 delegate serve as a Committee Chair. We encourage delegations to nominate their candidate from last year's Assembly if their candidate was not elected as a Presiding Officer.
- **Chaplain:** There will no longer be a separate role for Chaplain the role will be filled by a Presiding Officer at each Assembly, who will share a mission moment to focus students on the program's impact.
- Media Corps: Delegations can have one (1) Media Corps delegate (Editor-in-Chief and Assistant Editors do not count as the Media Corps delegate for their delegations). Pre-work (articles) may be assigned to Media delegates before the Assembly.
- Name Tags and Placards: Requests for new Name Tags and Placards must be submitted to the Y Desk by dinner on first night of the Assembly. Replacements will be ready the next morning.
  - **Missing** If a delegate never received a Name Tag or Placard (missing from materials given to the advisor), they will be re-printed and at the Y Desk the next morning. Until then, delegates will use a replacement Name Tag and/or Placard.
  - Lost/Damaged Placard If a delegate loses or damages a placard, they will receive branded replacement placards that read "Senator" or "Representative" (KYA) and "Ambassador" (KUNA).
- **Special Roles & Delegation Photos:** Due to the nature of the Assembly agenda, students with special roles (Presiding Officers, Supporting Officers, etc.) may miss official delegation photos. Advisors are encouraged to take additional photos at a time when their students are all together.

• **Premiere and Legislative:** The Premiere Program will be renamed "Bluegrass House and Senate" and the Legislative Program will be the "Commonwealth House and Senate." The new eligibility requirements for Bluegrass and Commonwealth are as follows:

- Congressional: There will no longer be a Congressional program at KYA.
- Judicial: Justices for KYA 2017 will not be selected at the 2016 Assemblies. During the fall of the 2017-2018 school year a Supporting Officer application will be released along with a selection process. The Chief Justice and Attorney General will continue to be selected at each KYA as Presiding Officers.
- Veto Override: If the Governor determines a veto could be avoided if one amendment were made (a single phrase, number, or item), the Governor can bring the bill up directly at the beginning of the veto override session to seek passage of the amendment and sign the bill into law. Bill Sponsors would be informed, but would not need to submit a petition. The amendment would require a simple majority to pass.
  - During Veto Override, the Governor may yield to another Presiding Officer to speak.
  - Bill Sponsors may yield to a Lobbyist.

### **High School KUNA**

- Cultural Attire: Hats can only be worn as part of Cultural Attire.
- **Global Village Booth:** A "Global Village Worker" position will be added to KUNA roles (up to 4 slots available). These students will be responsible for ensuring that your booth is staffed at all times (including during dinner), as well as ensuring that your booth is cleaned up by the designated time (failure to do so may result in disqualification from Global Village award).

- Global Village Booth (Continued):
  - Stamps & Native Phrase Students are encouraged, but not required, to bring a unique stamp for Global Village
    passports, as well as to learn a simple phrase in the native language of their country that they can teach guests.
  - Henna & Paint Henna/paint may not be applied in Global Village Booths, but students are allowed to arrive at KUNA with it already applied.
- International Stage: Music should be submitted electronically prior to KUNA. Additionally, Media Delegates may not participate in International Stage due to agenda conflicts.
- Security Council: Middle School Security Council is 8th grade only, and previous KUNA experience is preferred. Each school should submit one Security Council Resolution.
- International Court of Justice: Justices of the ICJ for KUNA 2018 will not be selected at the 2017 Assemblies. During the 2017-2018 school year a Supporting Officer application will be released along with a selection process. The 2 ICJ Presidents will continue to be selected at each KUNA as Presiding Officers.
