Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 211 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS: The "unknown" option pertaining to the awareness of lead hazards in properties for sale shall be removed and that properties shall be tested for the presence of lead paint. Homeowners under 200% of the poverty line shall receive full government assistance for lead testing.

Section 2: The funding for which shall be supplied by the Preventive Health and Health Services Block Grant which provides all 50 states, the District of Columbia, 2 American Indian tribes, and 8 US territories with funds to respond rapidly to emerging health issues and to fill funding gaps in programs that deal with leading causes of death and disability. Kentucky receives \$1,978,999 annually from this grant.
