1                   An Act relating to Altering Statutes Related to Rape in the Commonwealth of Kentucky  
2  
3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
4  
5 Section 1: Strike the current statute 510.01.08 which reads:  
6 ""Sexual intercourse' means sexual intercourse in its ordinary sense and includes penetration of the  
7 sex organs of one person by a foreign object manipulated by another person. "Sexual intercourse"  
8 occurs upon any penetration, however slight; emission is not required. "Sexual intercourse" does not  
9 include penetration of the sex organ by a foreign object in the course of the performance of generally  
10 recognized health-care practices; and"

12 and replace with the following:  
13  
14 ""Sexual Intercourse' constitutes genital penetration by any object, including genitals belonging to  
15 another person, manipulated by another person, or oral action by any foreign object in the context of  
16 sexual activity for prolonged periods of time manipulated by another person, including oral to genital  
17 contact. "Sexual intercourse" also includes prolonged hand to genital contact, even if penetration is not  
18 present. "Sexual intercourse" does not include penetration of the sex organ by a foreign object in the  
19 course of the performance of generally recognized health-care practices; and"  
20  
21 Section 2: In 510.040, 510.050, 510.070, 510.080, 501.100 , 510.140, 510.148, and 510.150  
22 strike "him" and "he" and replace with "him or her" and "he or she", respectively.  
23  
24 Section 3: This bill will be enacted one year after its passage.
