- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: The Kentucky law that gives counties the decision on whether or not employees should be
- 6 certified is amended to make all school systems require the certification.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: A new section of KRS chapter 702 KAR 1:160 School health services add the certification
- 9 requirements for CPR.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: The employee who is not certified with CPR faces the penalty that the school district
- 12 decides.
- 13
- 14 Section 4: There will be a CPR Training course offered by the county for employees before every school
- 15 year.
- 16
- 17 Section 5: This act takes effect on July 1, 2018.
