- 1 AN ACT relating to prohibit marriage for individuals under the age of 17
- 2
- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: This act will remove the clause that allows pregnant girls under the age of 16 to get married,
- 6 making it illegal.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: No individual under the age of 17 can be granted a marriage license, even with parental
- 9 consent.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: Individuals 17 years of age can be granted a marriage license if parental consent is provided.

- 13 Section 4: Any public official who knowingly signs a marriage license that would fail to meet the above
- 14 criteria will be subject to an ethics review conducted by the Kentucky Executive Branch Ethics
- 15 Commission.

- 17 Section 5: This bill will take effect on January 1st, 2018.
