- 1 AN ACT relating to establishing open primaries in all Kentucky elections.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: Undeclared voters shall be allowed to vote in all primary elections, for the candidate of their
- 6 choice.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: Voters registered as members of a particular party shall have the freedom to vote for the
- 9 candidate of their choice, regardless of party affiliation.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: This bill shall apply to all local, state, and federal elections in Kentucky.
- 12
- 13 Section 4: This bill requires no additional funding.
- 14
- 15 Section 5: This bill shall go into effect prior to the next primary election, on May 22, 2018.
