1 AN ACT relating to the Legalization of Physician-Assisted Suicide
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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
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5 Section 1: Physician-assisted suicide shall be made legal for persons that have made a living will and
6 have had five days of counseling over the matter if they are still in a conscious state.

8 Section 2: A physician must consent to the procedure and be licensed.
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10 Section 3: The procedure would occur by a 9 gram dosage of Secobarbital followed by a 10 gram
11 dosage of pentobarbital.

13 Section 4: In the instance that the person is in a coma or unconscious state and immediate family
14 members believe that the wishes have changed from the expressed wish to die written in the living will,
15 a decision may be made by the immediate family members in consultation with the physician and, if
16 wanted, a legal advisor.

18 Section 5: This bill shall go into effect January 1st 2018.
