- 1 An Act relating to lowering the required age to handle and serve alcohol at on-premise establishments.  
2
- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
4
- 5 Section 1: In the Commonwealth of Kentucky, the current legal age to handle and serve alcohol at on-  
6 premise establishments is 20 years. The purpose of this bill is to lower that requirement to 18 in order  
7 to allow more job opportunities for young adults.  
8
- 9 Section 2: This bill will amend the current state law (KRS 224.090).  
10
- 11 Section 3: A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 244 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS: Persons whom  
12 licensees may not employ -- Partial exception. (1) A person holding any license shall not knowingly  
13 employ in connection with the licensed business any person who: (c) Is under the age of eighteen (18)  
14 years, unless the person is employed: 1. In a bottling house or room of a licensed distiller, winery,  
15 brewer, or rectifier; 2. In an office of a wholesaler or manufacturer that is maintained in a building  
16 separate from the warehouses or factory; 3. At premises licensed only with a non quota retail malt  
17 beverage package license, and the person employed to sell malt beverages is at least eighteen (18)  
18 years of age and under the supervision of a person twenty (20) years of age or older; or 4. In any of  
19 the following establishments, if the employment is in a capacity that does not involve the sale or  
20 serving of alcoholic beverages: a. A restaurant that derives at least fifty percent (50%) of its food and  
21 alcoholic beverage sales from the sale of food for consumption on the licensed premises; or b. Any  
22 other establishment with alcoholic beverage sales not exceeding fifty percent (50%) of its gross sales...

- 24 Section 4: This bill will require no funding.
- 25  
26 Section 5: This bill will be implemented into state law May 1, 2018.
