KENTUCKY YMCA YOUTH ASSOCIATION GENERAL ADULT CODE OF CONDUCT

(Updated August 2018)

- 1. To protect YMCA staff, volunteers, and program participants, at no time during a Kentucky YMCA program may an adult be alone with a single youth where they cannot be observed by others. As adults interact with youth, they should space themselves in such a way that Y-Staff, volunteers, or other adults can see them.
- 2. No type of abuse will be tolerated and may be cause for immediate dismissal and reporting. Adults shall not abuse youth in any way, including
 - physical abuse—striking, spanking, shaking, slapping, and so on;
 - verbal abuse—humiliating, degrading, threatening, and so on;
 - sexual abuse—touching or speaking inappropriately;
 - mental abuse—shaming, withholding kindness, being cruel, and so on;
 - neglect—withholding food, water, or basic care.
 - bullying—verbally, physically, mentally, or electronically targeting another person maliciously
- 3. Adults will respond to youth with respect and consideration and treat all children equally, regardless of sex, gender/sexuality, race, religion, culture, socioeconomic status, or ability.
- 4. Adults will respect youths' rights not to be touched or looked at in ways that make them feel uncomfortable, and their right to say no.
- 5. Adult participants are not to transport youth alone in their personal vehicles. If a situation requires immediate travel and no one is available, remain on phone with parents/guardians the entire way and call Executive Administration for notification and/or approval.
- 6. Using, possessing, or being under the influence of substances while with youth is prohibited.
- 7. Smoking/Vaping or use of tobacco is prohibited while youth are present.
- 8. Possession or use of any type of weapon or explosive device is prohibited during programming.
- 9. Offensiveness, inappropriate jokes, sharing intimate details of one's personal life, and any kind of harassment in the presence of youth or parents is prohibited.
- 10. Adults must report to Y-Staff any other adult who violates any of the policies listed in this Code of Conduct.

I have reviewed the provisions of the Code of Conduct as listed above and agree to abide by it. I understand that the Kentucky YMCA may terminate my affiliation with the organization if I am found to be in violation of any of the provisions of this code. I also understand that criminal charges may be brought against me in the event that violation of this code also constitutes a violation of the law.
