## WRAPPING UP

Closing GA, Pizza Pick-up, Delegation Meetings: Once ranking committees have concluded all participants will gather again in the Crowne Ballroom for the closing GA of the day. Many important agenda items will be covered in this session: docket assignments for the next day's debate, announcement of chair, clerk, and doorkeeper positions for hotel chambers, candidate speeches, and any final updates. All delegates and adults should be present to hear this information. As the session is wrapping up, advisors will be dismissed to have first chance to pick up any pizzas their delegation has ordered over the course of the day. Finally, the GA will adjourn so that all delegations can gather at their pre-assigned delegation meeting spaces. Lists of assigned delegation meeting spaces can be found at the Y-Desk. The delegation meeting is a chance for the advisor and students to reflect on the day and discuss any preparations for the morning before students dismiss to their sleeping rooms.

**Curfew, Room Checks, Door-Taping:** Advisors are asked to conclude their delegation meetings with sufficient time for students to be in their sleeping rooms by the announced curfew. Advisors should conduct final room checks to ensure that all participants are in their assigned rooms by curfew. At no time should any participant be in a sleeping room other than the one assigned to them; additionally, once room checks are complete no student should leave their assigned sleeping room until the curfew end time printed in their bill books. Advisors are expected to help enforce this rule. Taping each sleeping room door with masking or painters tape at the bottom corner is optional, but encouraged. Advisors should immediately alert Y-Staff of any circumstance that necessitates students exiting their sleeping rooms before end of curfew.
