CLOSING GA, FINAL BALLOT, AWARDS, AND ADJOURNMENT

General Assembly and Final Ballot: After breakfast delegates and advisors will gather for the closing General Assembly. Presiding Officers will make their final addresses to the conference and students will cast their final votes for presiding officers for next year's conference. Advisors will be notified when ballots are ready for pick up at the Y-Desk; they are responsible for making sure each member of their delegation gets a ballot and the opportunity to cast their vote privately. Students are not required to share their vote with their peers or any other participant at the conference.

Awards: KYA is first and foremost an experiential learning event. While we do not consider KYA a competition, a series of awards will be given to recognize excellence in debate, bill creation and presentation, and student and delegation leadership.

Adjournment: The concluding event of the conference is the announcement of election results and the passing of gavels to the next set of student leaders. The members of the presiding officer team will make a final statement before the conference and then announce the student who will take their position next year, ending with the youth governor announcing his or her successor. The new set of presiding officers-elect will be lead in the official oath of office for Kentucky leaders and then formally adjourn the conference. Y-Staff and volunteers will be available to support delegations in retrieving their luggage and exiting the hotel.
