Hotel Chambers: The House and Senate chambers for "hotel-side" debate follow the exact same parliamentary procedure and have the exact same programmatic relevance. Bills passing in one hotel chamber must then be debated and voted on in the second chamber. Sponsors of bills passing both chambers will meet with the appropriate presiding officer and receive the same recognition as bills passed into law at the Capitol. Any sponsor who hasn't met with the Governor or Lt. Governor before Chambers close for the day will have the opportunity to do so at the end of the day by signing up for a meeting time at the Y-Desk. Whether your delegation starts or ends your debate day at the hotel, advisors should be moving between chambers, enjoying seeing their students in action, and assisting with safe and efficient transitions for travel and bill flow.
