EVENING ACTIVITIES

Free Time and dinner: Once all participants are back at the hotel, delegations will have some down time to go to their rooms, relax, change into casual clothing, and get ready for the evening's activities. Dinner is provided by the Y and will be served in the Crowne Ballroom in two rotations based on your "tag." Please check your conference agenda to know your tag's dinner time.

Mandatory Delegation Caucus: After dinner all delegations will gather in the Crowne Ballroom for a mandatory delegation caucus. Advisors are responsible for ensuring that 100% of their students are present and accounted for. Once 100% student attendance is confirmed advisors will be dismissed from the ballroom to take up their supervisory posts for the evening. This is also a good time for advisors to complete award nomination forms, which can be done online on a phone or personal computer or at the Y-Desk.

Announcements: With 100% of students present, Y-Staff will make some announcements and attend to some housekeeping items for the evening. Y-Staff will explain procedures for electing officers and the use of our conference voting machines; finally, the students will learn about their options for the evening's "mandatory fun time" and some important ground rules.

Mandatory Fun Time & Elections: Once students are dismissed from the caucus they are free to move between the rooms offering a variety of activities: a game room, a talent stage, a movie room, the ever-popular "gaga pit." (indoor dodgeball!), and other activities. Students are encouraged to have fun and build on the new friendships we hope they have created at the conference. Advisors are expected to help monitor students during this time. This is also the time that students should be going to the polls to cast their votes in the presiding officer primaries. Advisors should monitor their delegation's polling lists: 100% voter turn-out is required for your group to earn Premiere Delegation Status!

Final Announcements and Closing Thoughts: Once the mandatory fun time has concluded and we're moving to wrap up the day, all participants will gather in the Crowne Ballroom. The presiding officer team will make some final announcements and then go into their closing thoughts. The "closing thoughts" segment is the presiding officer team's opportunity to share their reflections on the previous days' debates and experiences. Advisors are urged to help model for their students the respect and attention for these proceedings that these young servant leaders deserve. The last announcement before dismissal will be the names of the candidates advancing from the primaries to the final ballot which will be held the next morning. Pizza pick up, delegation meetings, and curfew and room check arrangements will be the same as the first night of the conference.
