<p>Secretary of State <i>HS Only</i></p>	<p>The SoS focuses on engaging young voters, works with their full PO team, and leads the conference</p>	<p>Hold voter registration drives at their school (one per semester) and at their conference, train students on how to hold voter registration drive, work with CW candidates at conference, help lead pre-conference Candidate meeting, assist with PO elections at conference, committee-sit, rank Chairs/DKs, write an issue agenda brief.</p>
<p>Speaker of the House <i>HS: CW & BG</i></p>	<p>The SoH facilitates debate in their Chamber, works with their full PO team, engages with delegates, and leads the conference.</p>	<p>Committee-sit, train Chairs, fully understand Parliamentary Procedure, encourage students to speak up during debate, command your Chamber, give Call-to-Debate speech.</p> <p>HS Only: writes an issue agenda brief, hold a voter registration drive at school</p>
<p>President of the Senate <i>HS: CW & BG</i></p>	<p>The PoS facilitates debate in their Chamber, works with their full PO team, engages with delegates, and leads the conference.</p>	<p>Committee-sit, train Chairs, fully understand Parliamentary Procedure, encourage students to speak up during debate, command your Chamber, give Call-to-Debate speech, writes an issue agenda brief.</p> <p>HS Only: writes an issue agenda brief, hold a voter registration drive at school</p>
<p>Attorney General <i>HS Only</i></p>	<p>The Attorney General oversees the Constitutionality Room and supervises and coordinates their staff of attorneys as they develop legal determinations on bills before the General Assembly.</p>	<p>Ensure a collegial and effective working environment, delegate and direct work flow to ensure that all bills that may come before the Governor for signing or vetoing receive a thorough determination process, mentor and support their staff in developing legal reasoning skills and effective written expression.</p>
<p>Secretary of the Executive Cabinet <i>HS Only</i></p>	<p>The SEC oversees the Cabinet and Lobbyist Program. They serve as one of the Governors main advisors when it comes to making decisions on signing or vetoing bills.</p>	<p>Train and work with cabinet members leading up to KYA, facilitate each Cabinet/Lobbyist meeting at conference, invest time in understanding most, if not all, proposed bills, advise the Governor on said bills.</p>
<p>Chief Justice <i>HS Only</i></p>	<p>The Chief Justice leads the team of Justices that sit on the Supreme Court bench and is responsible for ensuring fair and equal justice in the deliberation of cases before the court. They set the tone and model the highest standards of judicial professionalism, diligence, and commitment.</p>	<p>Model high judicial standards through expert knowledge of the case at bar, questioning skills, and legal reasoning; ensure a collegial, fair, and effective bench; recognize the need to support attorneys and attorney teams of varying skill levels to advance the idea that all participants are seeking to pursue and achieve an arc of growth through the Supreme Court Program.</p>
<p>Editor-in-Chief <i>HS Only</i></p>	<p>The EIC manages the Media Corps program, and ensures that it produces quality journalism and content in a timely and efficient manner.</p>	<p>Directly supervise, support, and check in with Assistant Editor team to troubleshoot and ensure deadlines are being met, support and answer questions from individual team members, run all full team meetings, set up Press Conference and coordinate necessary POs, give updates on Media Corps in General Assemblies, push the envelope creatively and come up with new and exciting ideas for the team to explore, regularly communicate with team and Y-Staff.</p>
<p>Lt. Governor</p>	<p>The Lt. Governor engages with delegates, works with their full PO team, reviews BG bills, and leads the conference.</p>	<p>Work with candidates, help lead pre-conference Candidate meeting, review passed bills, meet with bill sponsors, rank Chairs/DKs, and committee sit.</p> <p>HS Only: work closely with BG Candidates, writes an issue agenda brief</p>
