This requirement is necessary to account for all students and keep them safe.

Closing session will adjourn and students will be dismissed to begin departure at approximately 6:30pm CENTRAL. At that time students will be asked to gather all items and belongings. Once students are ready to leave the conference site, the child & parent/guardian/other designated adult should check in with Y-staff. At that time students will be cleared to leave the conference site.

Please be on site by 6:30pm CENTRAL at the very latest to pick up your child.

By 7:00pm CENTRAL, if we have not checked out your student with an approved adult, we will contact you via cell phone.

Who Can Pick Up Your Child

Only adults 16 years of age and older listed on a student's Release Form will be able to take students from the conference site. In case of a last-minute change or addition, please contact the conference director. Email authorization is accepted from a parent/guardian's email address that we already have on record. The Kentucky YMCA will not release students to anyone, under any circumstance, other than those stated above. Anyone picking up students must carry a photo ID.
